REWG Community Council and the British Red Cross

The British Red Cross has been in contact with the Community Council to offer a range of free first aid courses, provisionally set for one week in the middle of January 2009. There will be places for 20 people to take part in a one-day general course with time available, depending upon demand, for a further intake of 20 or, if required, more specialised training in relevant injuries (e.g. crushing rather than chemical burns). Time will be set aside to train volunteers on Egislay and Wyre for the proposed supply of defibrillators.
