Allotment news

All plots outside are taken this year with plot holders reaping the benefits of home grown produce. The polytunnel is looking like a green jungle full of a large variety of fruit and vegetables ready to harvest.

Water on the site

After waiting several months we have been informed we are not able to take over the old water board bore hole. We are now investigating the options with the cost implications involved. We are awaiting quotes for having a new bore hole on the site to compare with the cost of using the mains supply.

We intend to sort this ongoing issue over the winter, ready for next spring.

Pots

We have a large quantity of second hand pots available at the allotment, as well as other items for sale such as seed trays, cloches, sticks etc. Prices available on request.

Compost

Compost is available in large bags, which can be kept and refilled. If you are an associate member of the allotment association you can take advantage of the compost. The large bags are £15 each including £5 for cost of bag, which you can return for refill. Delivery can be negotiated, phone me for details.
